
TEXT 1 高校生の Hiro は、家事(housework)に関する発表を行った。

We have more time at home than before because of *COVID-19. How do you spend your time? Some students study a lot, and others play video games or read *manga*. How about housework? Do you do any housework?


My parents are teachers, so they are busy every day. I have been <u>① help</u> my family with housework since I was small. Every morning, I make breakfast with my father. After breakfast, I usually take our dog Max to the park. My sister cleans the *bathtub every day. She sometimes helps my mother cook dinner and wash the dishes. There are many other kinds of housework. For example, *taking out the *trash, cleaning the *toilet, washing and folding clothes, and taking care of pets if you have some. I think doing housework is important for all of us.

Look at Graphs 1 and 2. I found these graphs in the school newspaper. Graph 1 shows how often the students at our school do housework. According (②) the graph, about 60 percent do some housework *at least once a week. However, only 15 percent do it every day. There are about 40 percent of students who never do housework. I was surprised that so many students never do it.

What are the reasons for doing no housework? Graph 2 shows the reasons. Students who never do housework were asked the reasons, and 391 students answered. The largest number of students answered that they were busy with studying. I'm interested in the second reason. More than 100 students answered that they were not asked to do any housework. I do not know why parents do not ask their children to do housework. I showed these graphs to my parents and asked them about 1 to do housework. I showed these graphs are 1 their / how / to / busy / too / children / teach 1 to do housework. My mother said teaching needed a lot of 6 patience. She also said, "It takes time until children learn to do housework such as cooking and cleaning." My parents taught me many kinds of housework. I think I'm lucky to have good parents.

Last month, our class went camping. I found that some students did nothing when we were *preparing for dinner. I think they did not know what they should do. Doing housework helps us learn many skills (⑦) are important for our lives. We should do some housework as a member of a family *even if we are busy or tired.

TEXT 2 Hiro の発表後に、同級生の Miki が感想を述べた。

When I was a junior high school student, I often helped my family. I was not a member of any club at school, so I had time. After coming back home from school, I often went shopping for dinner at the supermarket near my house. I often enjoyed cooking dinner and washing the dishes with my mother, too.

Things changed after I entered high school. I became busy with studying and club activities. I practice tennis after school every day. I sometimes study in the library until eight in the evening. So I don't do any housework these days. My parents also do not ask me for help.

After listening to Hiro's speech, I changed my *mind. My father is a doctor, and my mother works at a library. They are busy every day. I realized that everyone in my family is busy. (<u>()</u> I think I should do it because I'm a member of my family. After I *graduate from high school, I want to go to a university in Tokyo. I'm going to live *by myself. So doing housework will also be good *training.

ミキは中学生のときに、夕食の準備や皿洗いを手伝い始めた。高校生になって勉強や部活動が忙しくなったが、ヒロと同じように毎日家事を続けている。

ミキは、中学生のときには家事を手伝っていたが、高校生になってからは勉強や 部活動が忙しいため家事をしていない。しかし、ヒロの発表を聞いて自分の家事 に関する考えを改めた。

ミキは、高校生になってから勉強や部活動が忙しいため家事をしていない。ヒロ の発表を聞いて、家事よりも勉強や部活動を優先する考えが正しいものだと再認 識した。
